This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, U.S. code section 28-1 for the Cotton #1-22 contiguous lode mining claims, located in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada

The work consisted of:

Soil sampling on Cotton #1-22 between June 7, 1987 and June 10, 1987, and 196 samples analyzed thru ACME Labs.

This work was performed upon the Cotton #1-22 lode mining claims to evaluate the discovery of valuable mineral deposits located thereon and to assist in planning further development work.
