SUMMARY REPORT ROGER CLAIMS (SECTION 32)

(SECTION 32, T35N, R48E MDM)

This report is filed in compliance with the requirements of 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the Roger Claims Title #1-4; 6; 8-18; 25-42, a contiguous group of 34 claims in the Unknown Mining District of Lander and Eureka Counties, State of Nevada.

The work consisted of geological mapping and geochemical sampling of the entire claim group. The work was initiated and completed during the month of August, 1987 by James R. Guilinger of 6770 Coors Ct., Arvada, CO 80004, a geologist with 15 years experience in exploration and development geology with a B.A. degree in Geology (1973) from the University of Colorado. The cost of the geological/geochemical work exceeded \$3,400.00 and was paid for by Western States Minerals Corporation.

The geologic work involved detailed mapping of outcrop and structures. All information was plotted on 1"=100' scale base map. Additionally, alteration features were also plotted on this same scale map.

The geochemical work consisted of detailed rock chip sampling of all areas altered outcrop. All samples were submitted to Barringer Labs of Sparks, Nevada for both atomic absorption and fire assay determinations. Pending final evaluation of assay results, areas of anomalous mineral concentration will be selected for drilling.
