To tie this claim to the Public Survey, begin at the Southeast Corner of
Section 22, Township 21 N., Range 51 E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian,
thence North, approximately 16,000 feet and West, approximately
15,930 feet to the Northwest corner (Cor. No. 1) of this claim.

We (or I) claim 840 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge,
lode or vein, extending 830 feet from the location monument in a Westerly
direction and 10 feet in an Easterly direction, together with 125 feet on
each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The exterior boundaries of this claim are clearly marked by substantial
3 inch x 5 foot long plastic post monuments firmly set in the ground and bearing
applicable monument designation. The description of such claim is:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner (Corner No. 1),

thence, East, 420 feet to the North Side Center (Cor. No. 2),

thence, East, 420 feet to the Northeast Corner (Cor. No. 3),

thence, South, 250 feet to the Southeast Corner (Cor. No. 4),

thence, West, 420 feet to the South Side Center (Cor. No. 5),

thence, West, 420 feet to the Southwest Corner (Cor. No. 6),

thence, North, 250 feet to the Northwest Corner (Cor. No. 1),
the point and place of beginning.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 26th day of
September, 1987.

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two
copies of this claim map have been filed with the Eureka County Recorder, and the
lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
