The Claim is approximately 1500 feet long and 300 feet wide, such that 100 feet is claimed in a westerly direction and 1400 feet in a easterly direction from the point of discovery (monument of location), at which the Notice of Location was posted, together with 150 feet on each side of the monument of location and center line of the Claim. The general course of the lode or vein is from the east to the west direction.
