CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF LODE MINING CLAIM

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The undersigned hereby certifies that it has located the Red 21 Lode Mining Claim in Section 16, T. 31 N., R. 52 E., in an unknown mining district, Elko County and Eureka County, in the State of Nevada, on the 5th day of November, 1987.

The claim is 1500 feet long and 500 feet wide and 20 feet is claimed in an easterly direction and 1480 feet in a westerly direction from the location monument, at which the Notice of Location is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 250 feet in width on each side of the center of the claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the east to the west.

The location and number of each corner of this claim is shown on the claim map that is filed herewith. On the ground, each corner of the claim is marked with its appropriate number by scribed metal tag.

The description of each corner is as follows:

Corner No. 1 is a 3" plastic pipe.
Corner No. 2 is a 3" plastic pipe.
Corner No. 3 is a 3" plastic pipe.
Corner No. 4 is a 3" plastic pipe.
Corner No. 5 is a 3" plastic pipe.
Corner No. 6 is a 3" plastic pipe.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 15th day of November, 1987. (Must be within 60 days of posting notice of location.)

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map have been filed with the Elko and Eureka County Recorders, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to each County Recorder.
