Mount Diablo Meridian, NV, and said claim lies within the
126N R 54E and NE 1/4, Sec. 3, T25N, R54E, MDB.
from this discovery monument the undersigned claims 20 feet in a/an South direction, and 1480 feet in a/an North direction. The claim is 600 feet wide and 1500 feet long.

The surface boundaries of the claim are described as beginning at the discovery monument and running thence 20 feet to the center of the South end line and the true point of beginning, thence (clockwise) West 300 ft. to corner no. 2, thence North 750 ft. to corner no. 3, thence South 750 ft. to corner no. 4, thence East 600 ft. to corner no. 5, thence South 750 ft. to the point of beginning.

There are 7 posts of durable plastic pipe at least 3 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet long set 1 foot in the ground, one for the discovery monument, one for each of the four corners and one at the center of each side line as prescribed by N.R.S. Section 517.030.

Location work for this mining claim consisted of preparing and filing a map of said claim as provided in Section 517.040, Nevada Revised Statutes.
