TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the Second Part, and to her heirs and assigns forever.

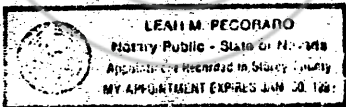
