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

A program of combined Induced Polarization and Electrical Resistivity geophysics was performed on the Kimberly and AG claims for Tonkin Springs Gold Mining Company by Geo-Western Geophysics, Inc. The program consisted of two east-west horizontal profiles, roughly 8,000 feet apart covering a combined total of 3.34 line miles. Work was performed by or under the supervision of Van Hewitt of Geo-Western, and this report prepared by Ron Espell, Geologist with U.S. Gold Corporation. Field work and data correlation was completed by the end of July.

Results of the combined geophysical program were generally inconclusive due to the depth of overlying alluvium and Tertiary volcanics. Field checking of the data did show strong correlation between the geophysical data and regional structure. From the data generated, a detailed drill program is planned for next season to explore the mineralization potential along the indicated structures.
