

Yater, an expert qualified by both education and experience, conducted a geophysical survey over the said claims, the field work having been done on August 26 and 27, 1988, and the analysis of the data and preparation of a map and report having been done prior to September 1, 1988. This investigation was done at the instance and expense of Wilson Mineral Properties, Inc. The survey consisted of a radiation survey of portions of the surface of the claims, utilizing a Geometrics Exploranium scintillation counter, model GR101A, which measures the radiation present at the surface of the earth by detecting gamma radiation emanating principally from geologic material near the surface of the earth. A map showing the basic findings of the survey is attached and made a part hereof.

The writer has a BS degree in Geology from Texas A & M, and has worked as a Geologist for 3 years with the U. S.
