DEED OF PARTIAL RECONVEYANCE

This Deed of Partial Reconveyance, dated as of August 11, 1988, is made by FIRST AMERICAN TITLE COMPANY OF NEVADA, a Nevada corporation (the "Trustee"), whose address is 518 Idaho Street, Elko, Nevada 89801, and THE TORONTO-DOMINION BANK, a Canadian Chartered Bank, as secured party and beneficiary (the "Bank"), whose address is Chicago Branch, 3 First National Plaza, Suite 1900, Chicago, Illinois 60602.

RECITALS

- 1. Barrick Goldstrike Mines Inc., a Delaware corporation, PanCana Minerals, Inc., a Colorado corporation, and Barrick Goldstrike Joint Venture, a joint venture consisting of Barrick Goldstrike Mines Inc. and PanCana Minerals, Inc. (collectively, the "Borrower"), have entered into a Gold Loan Agreement dated as of February 23, 1988 (the "Gold Loan Agreement") with the Bank.
- 2. Pursuant to the Gold Loan Agreement, the Borrower has executed in favor of the Trustee for the benefit of the Bank a Mortgage, Deed of Trust, Security Agreement and Financing Statement dated as of February 23, 1988 (the "Mortgage"), whereby the Borrower grants to the Bank the liens and security interests which are called for in the Gold Loan Agreement.
- 3. The Mortgage has been recorded in Book 172, Page 546 of the real estate records of Eureka County, Nevada, filed as UCC File No. 1217 of the Uniform Commercial Code records of Eureka County, Nevada, recorded in Book 605, Page 575 of the real estate records of Elko County, Nevada, and filed as File No. 11312 of the Uniform Commercial Code records of Elko County, Nevada.
- 4. The Borrower desires to convey to a third party certain unpatented millsite or mining claims that are subject to the Mortgage and the Gold Loan Agreement.
- 5. The Bank wishes to consent to the conveyance by the Borrower of such unpatented millsite or mining claims to such third party, and the Bank and Trustee wish to release such claims from the provisions of the Mortgage.

RECONVEYANCE

In consideration of the mutual promises contained in the Mortgage, the debts and trusts described therein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged:

- 1. The Bank hereby consents to the conveyance by the Borrower of the unpatented millsite or mining claims located in Eureka County, Nevada, described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Released Claims").
- 2. The Bank, as the lender under the Gold Loan Agreement and as the beneficiary, mortgagee and secured party under the Mortgage, hereby reconveys to the Borrower, without warranty to title, and releases from the terms of the Gold Loan Agreement and Mortgage, the Released Claims.
- 3. The Trustee, as the trustee under the Mortgage, hereby reconveys to the Borrower, without warranty of title, and releases from the terms of the Mortgage, the Released Claims.

This instrument does not impair the rights of the Bank or the Trustee to such property that is subject to the Mortgage and Gold Loan Agreement and not otherwise described herein.
