EXHIBIT B

To Whom It May Concern:

This report is in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the SM1-SM27 Claim Group (See Exhibit "A") within Surveyed Sections 20, T34N, R50E, MDB&M., unknown mining district, Eureka County, Nevada.

Work done on the Property consisted primarily of detailed geologic mapping, and geochemical surveys over the entire claim group, to evaluate the presence of valuable mineral deposits located thereon and to facilitate planning further deposits located thereon and to facilitate planning further exploration and development work. This work was done between 1988 by Wojtek Wodzicki, Graduate Geologist and Robert Suda, Graduate Geologist in behalf of Beaver Creek Gold Mining Company. The above work exceeded \$100 per claim and was paid for by Cominco American Resources, 831 E. Glendale Avenue, Sparks, Nevada, 89431.

The above unpatented lode mining claims overlie a sequence of west dipping sequence of silts, shale, cherts with minor sandstone and sandstone of apparent Ordovician age. rocks form subdued, rolling topography with small, scattered outcrops mainly along a north trending ridge. Much of the western and eastern portions of the property is covered by colluvium, which may conceal Paleozoic rocks. Local zones of chert breccia suggest north-trending structures, although these could not be traced over any distance.

Local zones of brecciation with weak silicification, bleaching, and minor quartz veining are found throughout the Results of over 35 rock chip and 28 soil claims area. samples indicate the presence of anomalous gold, silver,

samples indicate the presence of arsenic, antimony, and mercury throughter the presence of potentially economic levels of mineralization within the claim boundaries. Additional surface work, which will most certainly lead to drilling, is warranted. A program of detailed surface sampling and possible geophysics will aid a better understanding of the extent and nature of mineralization.
