

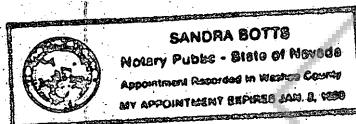

SUMMARY PROGRESS REPORT - MT. HOPE - MH-MHA (KTH) CLAIMS
EUREKA COUNTY, NEVADA

This report is filed on behalf of Placer Dome U.S. Inc., in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code Section 23-1. This report has been prepared by L.J. Stewart, a geologist of 24 years experience in mineral exploration, with a Bachelor of Science degree (geology major, mathematics minor) from University of Texas at El Paso (formerly Texas Western College), and a member in good standing of American Institute of Professional Geologists (CPG #1743). Surveying of base lines was done by Keith R. Blair, a geological engineer of some 2 years experience, with a BS degree (geological engineering) from Montana College of Mineral Science and Technology (1985). Rock sampling, supervision of gridding, and supervision of drilling program was done by Matthew D. Gray, a geologist of 2 years experience in mineral exploration, with degrees from Colorado School of Mines (BS, Geological Engineering, 1985) and the University of Arizona (MS, Economic Geology, 1988).

Work on the Mt. Hope claim group consisted of:

1. Moving and setting up camp facilities from Currie and Ely, Nevada to Mt. Hope Project campsite at Henderson Summit by Placer Dome employees L.J. Stewart and C.P. Osborn.
2. Surveying grid base lines (N-S and E-W) by Placer Dome employees K.R. Blair, L.J. Stewart, C.P. Osborn, A. Boyd.
3. Drilling of 5 angle reverse circulation drill holes and one vertical by contractor's drill rig and crew.
4. Sampling drill cuttings for assay by Placer Dome employees B.D. Caldwell, A. Boyd, C.P. Osborn.
5. Supervision of 6-hole reverse circulation angle and vertical drilling program by Placer Dome Employees M.D. Gray and L.J. Stewart.
6. Surveying grid (E-W lines) by Placer Dome employees A. Boyd and C.P. Osborn.
7. Rock and soil sampling and transportation of rock and soil samples to assayer by Placer Dome employees M.D. Gray, A. Boyd, C.P. Osborn and B.D. Caldwell.

All the work and drill holes are located on the Garden Pass, Nevada 7.5' U.S.G.S. topographic quadrangle map (Provisional Edition 1986).

Mt. Hope Summary Report
L.J. Stewart

The total cost of moving and setting up camp, surveying grid base lines and grid, supervision of 6-hole drill program, rock and soil sampling and transportation of samples to assayer exceeded \$11,400.00.

The total cost of drilling of 6 reverse circulation angle and vertical (1) drill holes, sampling of drill cuttings for assay and transportation of same to assayer exceeded \$22,400.00.

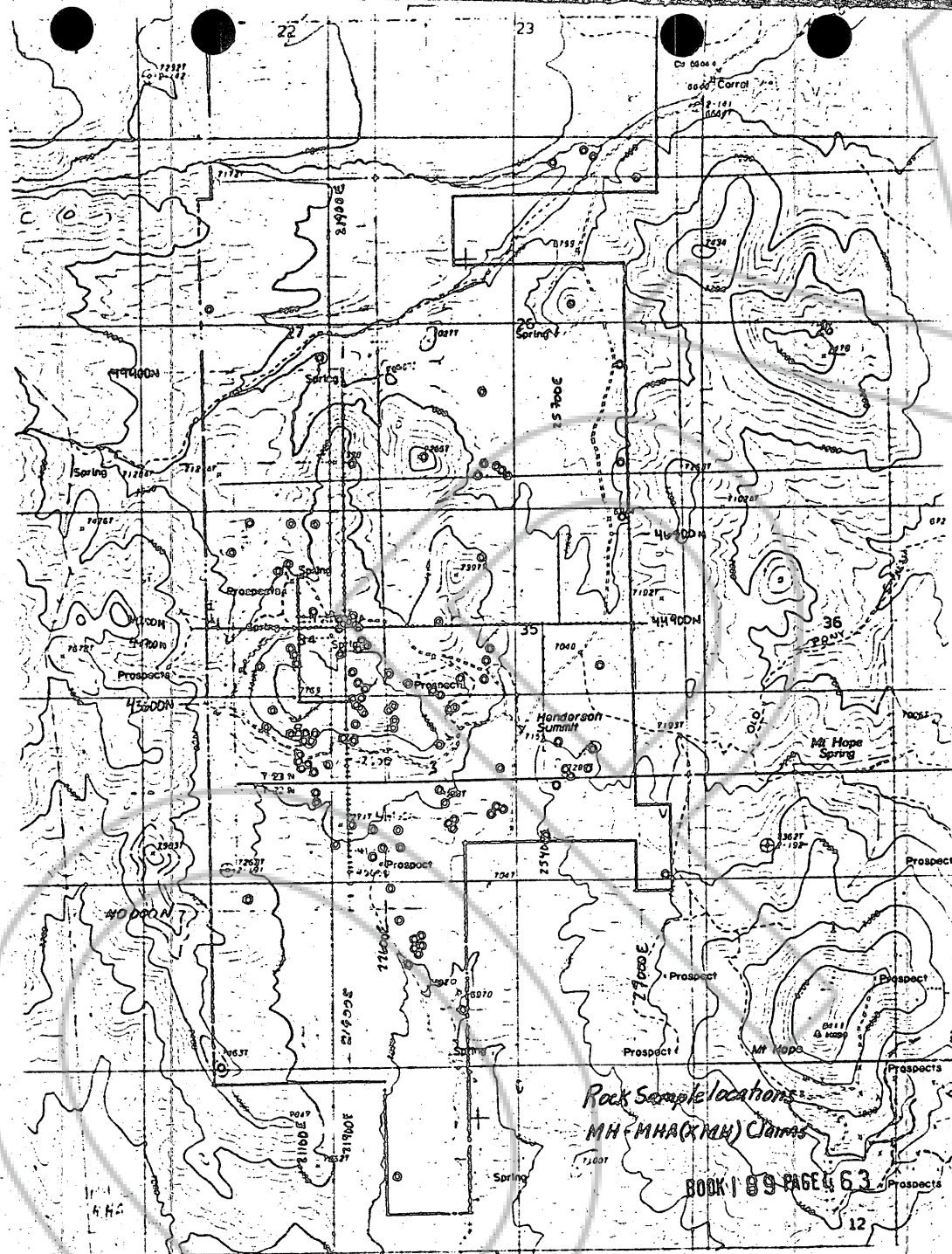
Total expenditures to be used for the 1987-88 assessment year exceeded \$33,800.00.

The surveying of base lines was done to establish various grids for the collecting and sieving of soil samples from 15 inches depth. The assays of the soil and rock samples should delineate anomalous zones which can be drilled in the immediate future in exploring for an economic mineral deposit.
