The name of the claim is

Eastern Mountain Group

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The claim is approximately 1300 feet long and 600 feet wide, such that 10 feet is claimed in a southeasterly direction and 1490 feet in a northwesterly direction from the point of discovery (monument of location), at which the Notice of Location was posted, together with 300 feet on either side of the monument of location and center line of the claim. The general course of the lode or vein is northwesterly and southeasterly.

The number, location and markings on each side center or corner monument are as follows:

No.	Location	Markings	Description
No. 1:	NE Corner	BRR 220, Post No. 1	3" or 4" PVC Post
No. 2:	SE Corner	BRR 220, Post No. 2	3" or 4" PVC Post
No. 3:	S Side Center	BRR 220, Post No. 3	3" or 4" PVC Post
No. 4:	SW Corner	BRR 220, Post No. 4	3" or 4" PVC Post
No. 5:	NW Corner	BRR 220, Post No. 5	3" or 4" PVC Post
No. 6:	N Side Center	BRR 220, Post No. 6	3" or 4" PVC Post

As erected on the ground, each side center or corner monument is marked as described above by a metal tag.

The work of location consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040.
