And it further appearing to the satisfaction of this Court that a Notice Lis Pendens in said action has been duly filed in the Office of the Recorder of Eureka County, Nevada; that a copy of the Summons in this action, describing the property as mentioned in the Complaint, has been regularly and duly posted on the parcel of land as described in the Complaint; that prior to the filing of this Complaint, Plaintiffs and their predecessors in interest have paid all taxes of every kind levied or assessed and due against the property as mentioned in the Complaint for more than five years last past; that Plaintiffs, and their predecessors in interest, have been in the actual and exclusive and adverse possession of said property described in the Complaint for more than fifteen years prior to the filing of said Complaint; and that all and each of the Defendants in this action have been duly and regularly served with process by publication in the manner required by law.
