NOTICE AND CLAIM OF MECHANICS' LIEN

TO ALL PERSONS, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Scott Company of California, a California corporation authorized and doing business in the State of Nevada and a licensed Nevada contractor, pursuant to NRS Chapter 108.222 et seq. does hereby claim the benefit of its mechanics' lien and all statutory remedies arising thereunder as follows:

1. The value of this claim of lien equals the principal sum of Nine Hundred, Twenty-Four Thousand, One Hundred Thirty-Five and 00/100 Dollars (\$924,135.00).
2. The owner or reputed owner is the Newmont Gold Company.
3. The Claimant herein entered into a contract with Bechtel, Inc., the owner's construction manager, on the 22nd day of December, 1988 and the work was performed under and pursuant to the direction given by Bechtel, Inc.
4. The contract was for the total sum of \$1.9 million (approximately) together with anticipated change orders and contract modifications. This claim includes a remaining retention on the original contract in the amount of \$192,435.00 together with Claimant's additional claims in the additional principal sum of \$731,700.00.
5. The work was to be performed within a reasonable time as stated within the terms of the contract and Scott Company of California, pursuant to the terms of the contract, was to perform specified piping installation within the structures located at Mill No. 4 located at the Newmont Gold Company, Mine, 26 miles north of Carlin, Eureka County, Nevada.
6. This Lien attaches to the real property and fixtures, structure and improvements located thereon known as the Newmont Gold Company Mill No. 4, approximately 26 miles north of Carlin, Nevada, located within the Newmont Gold Mine, Eureka County, Nevada. The land subject to the lien consists of the site owned and operated by Newmont Gold Company as a gold ore processing facility, which facility began operation in or about June, 1989.
7. The last date of work performed by Claimant was May 24, 1989 for purposes of NRS 108.226.

8. Claimant claims the benefit of all statutory entitlement included, but not limited to, interest on sums due, costs incurred and attorneys' fees incurred in having to prosecute the claim as hereinabove set forth.

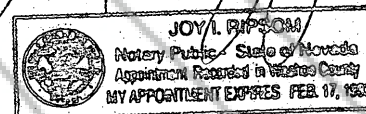
