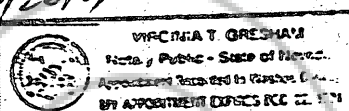

INFORMATION ABOUT MECHANICS' LIENS

A mechanics' lien must be recorded within 90 days after the completion of the work of improvement as a whole unless the owner records a notice of completion. If a notice of completion is recorded, the mechanics' lien must be recorded within 30 days thereafter unless the claimant is a general contractor or specialty contractor who contracted directly with the owner; in which case the mechanics' lien must be recorded within 60 days after the notice of completion was recorded. A mechanics' lien originates unless a foreclosure suit is filed within 90 days after the lien was recorded. The Mechanics' Lien Law is frequently amended. If you have any questions as to procedure, see your attorney.

These are the basic time periods for filing a mechanics' lien on these time periods. For a full explanation of the Mechanics' Lien Law, see "Industry Publishing Company, 1560 Law Special, (Bureau of Industry Publishing Company, 1560 Corwin Avenue, 100 Springs, California 94525).

RECORDING INFORMATION

The mechanics' lien must be recorded in the County where the project is located. The fee for recording a mechanics' lien is \$1.00 plus \$2.00 per page for each page or fraction thereof. However, the fee for recording a mechanics' lien is reduced to \$1.00 per page for each page or fraction thereof if the lien is recorded in the County where the project is located. Since the recorder will not record a document unless it is accompanied by the correct fee.

INTEREST RATES

To establish the proper interest rate to be applied on the mechanics' lien, see the contract provisions. If the contract does not specify the rate or if the contract is oral, the legal rate of interest is 10% per annum.
