AFFIDAVIT OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENT WORK

The undersigned hereby certifies that at least ONE HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$100.00) per claim was expended for development, labor and improvement, or equivalent value added, as the annual assessment work for the assessment year ending September 1, 1989 for the following unpatented lode mining claims located in Eureka County, Nevada:

BRR #1 through 216, 218, and 220 through 224, (a total of 222 lode claims) as further described on Appendix "A" attached hereto.

The work done included a ground magnetometer survey and its interpretation over part of the claim area; drill site preparation, 625 feet of reverse-circulation rotary drilling of one hole, geological supervision, sample preparation and assaying of drill samples. The drill hole was located on claim BRR No. 427 (contiguous to BRR #192) in the SE 1/4 of Section 8, T20N, R51E, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said work was performed between April 1, 1989 and August 31, 1989. A total of more than TWENTY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$22,200.00) was expended in performing the work, or equivalent value added. The drilling was performed by Parsons Drilling, 2054 Thomas Jefferson Ave., Battle Mountain, Nevada 89820. Sample analyses were done by Geochemical Services, Inc., 3805 Atherton Road, Rocklin, California 95677. The ground magnetometer survey was performed by Jon P. Broderick, geologist, 450 Yellow Pine Road, Reno, Nevada 89511; Ralph J. Roberts, geologist, 104 West Kinnear Place, Seattle, Washington 98119; and Robert G. Reeves, geologist, 4040 Lakeside Drive, Odessa, Texas 79762; each of whom are principals of BRR Resources, Inc. The geophysical work was done under the supervision of Robert G. Reeves whose qualifications to direct and interpret such work include the following experience and education: BS Mining Engineering, U. of Nevada, Reno, 1949; MS Geology (Geophysics Option), Stanford U., 1950; PhD, Geology (Economic and Geochemistry), Stanford U., 1965. Geologist and geophysicist, U.S. Geological Survey, 1949-69, 1973-8; Professor of Geology, Colorado School of Mines, 1969-73; Professor of Geology (Chairman, Dept. of Geology and Dean, College of Science and Engineering), The U. of Texas of the Permian Basin, 1978-85; Geological and Mining Consultant, 1985-present. Work with U.S. Geological Survey included 5 years as Chief, N. Nevada Geophysical Project (acquisition and interpretation of ground magnetic and gravity data and interpretation of aeromagnetic data in north-central Nevada).

All of the aforesaid unpatented lode mining claims are mutually contiguous, and contiguous with additional BRR claims which are part of the overall BRR Claim Group, and work on, or for the benefit of, any one claim or group of claims tends to develop all the claims. The work was performed for the purpose of

developing the mineral potential of the claims and to maintain and hold such claims.

Detailed Report on Geophysical Work
By: Robert G. Reeves

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-2 in order to report on the findings of the geophysical surveys.

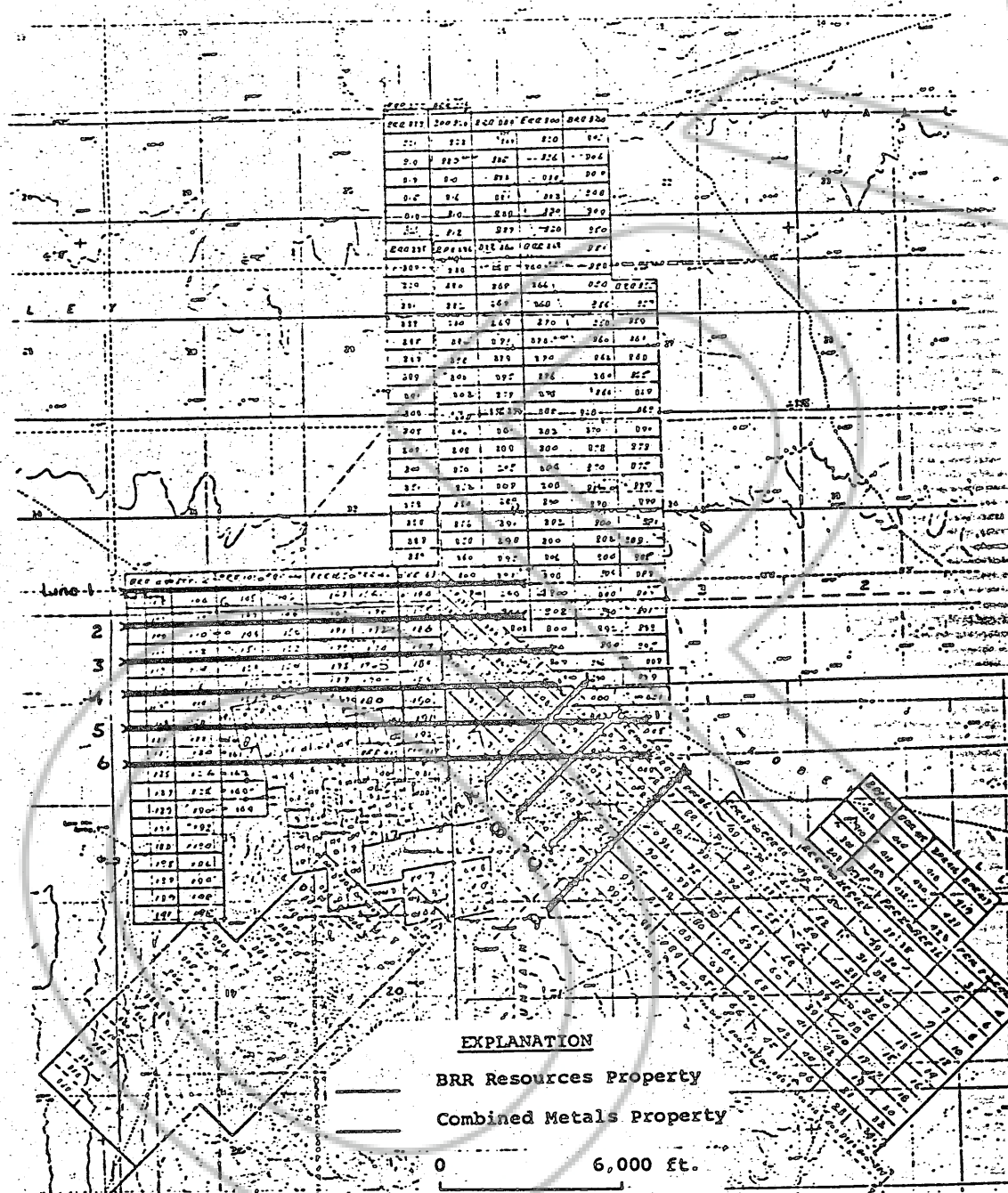


Figure 1. Map of BRR claims, Lone Mountain area, showing location of ground magnetic lines 1-6 and A-I

1. The ground magnetic survey consists of 23.55 line miles of traverse, with traverse lines spaced at 1,200 ft. or 1,500 ft. apart and stations along the traverse at 400 ft., 375 ft., 200 ft., 100 ft., or 50 ft. intervals. The location of the survey with respect to the claim block is shown in the accompanying map (fig. 1).

2. The survey disclosed the existence of major faults and magnetic bodies interpreted to be dikes and small stocks of igneous rock. These structures and intrusive bodies are believed to exert an influence on the distribution of gold ore deposits, and the knowledge of their existence and distribution will be helpful in preparing a future drilling program.

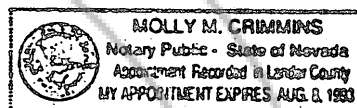
