I, Earl W. Abbott, agent for Trinia Resources Inc., lessee, being first duly sworn, state:

I. That, as required and authorized by 30 U.S.C. Sec. 28, NRS Sec. 517.230 and C.F.R. INTRODUCTION

Assessment work on the BE claim block for 1989 consisted of a Geochemical Survey managed by a consultant to Trinin Resources Inc., Dr. Earl W. Abbott of Reno, Nevada and conducted by employees of Phoenix Geoscience Inc. of Denver, Colorado.

WORK PERFORMED

The geophysical work consisted of an I.P.-Resistivity Survey, run on 4 lines totalling 23,200 feet. The survey was conducted during the period between August 17, 1989 and August 25, 1989.

APPLICABILITY

The work described in this report was performed for and during the assessment year ending September 1, 1989, to be applied to 64 claims owned by N. J. Dircks and leased to Trinin Resources. These claims are more fully described in Exhibit "A".

COST ANALYSIS

Geophysical Survey \$ 12,775.00

QUALIFICATIONS

Dr. Earl W. Abbott is qualified by education and experience to manage geophysical surveys. He holds a PhD in Geology from Rice University, Houston, Texas and has 18 years practical experience in the field of economic geology. Dr. Abbott is a Fellow of the Geological Association of Canada. GEOPHYSICAL FINDINGS
