

2. Dates and number of leases - File three (3) completed and executed oil and gas leases in appropriate land office. A \$10 non-refundable filing fee must accompany application. One assignment per lease except for lease plans and unitized agreements.
3. Effective date of assignment - Assignment, if unrecorded, takes effect on the first day of the month following the date of filing of all required papers.
4. Governing statutes and procedures for production - Governs in accordance with applicable state or federal laws and regulations.

Leases created by assignment but not yet put into effect, if payments due or production are retained by assignee, authorizes to deduct the amount retained as payment, and other pertinent taxes.

5. Effect of Assignment - Assignment of a definitely delineated portion of the leased lands creates separate leases. Assignee, upon completion of all work required by the original lease, may file a new lease or leases, including timely payment of annual rental and maintenance of one hundred bond, subject to due date of assignments of undivided interests, royalties, and operating agreements.
6. A copy of the executed lease, and all exhibits and appendices to lease, should be made available to examine by examiner.
