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SUMMARY REPORT

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the RME 1 through RME 163 (inclusive) contiguous lode mining claims located in Eureka County, Nevada.

The work consisted of geological evaluations of the entire claim block and preparation of a geological report. In addition, a gravity geophysical survey was conducted by a contractor for BP Minerals America of Salt Lake City, Utah. The work was conducted over the entire claim block during the assessment year period from September 1, 1988 through August 31, 1989. The basic finding was that the property is a good quality covered target area in which mineralization may have been introduced into receptive host rocks along a major NW trending fault zone.

The work was directed by Patrick C. Cavanaugh of 729 Aronson Ave., Billings, Montana. Mr. Cavanaugh is a geologist with 15 years experience in exploration and a M.S. in geology from the University of Montana. The work was performed over the entire claim block.
