#70 and CT #1 through #12.

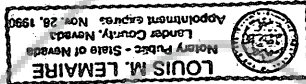

