Such expenditure was made by Noranda Exploration, Inc., the owner of the claims.

The work done consisted of a geochemical soil sampling survey within the boundaries of the claim block. 184 soil samples were taken on 200 foot x 200 foot spacing during the survey. See sample location map (Exhibit "A") attached hereto, for location of samples collected upon the claim block.

Said work was performed between the dates of August 4, 1989 and August 17, 1989. A total of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty Seven Dollars (\$7,987.00) was expended in performing the work and was done by employees of Noranda who are qualified by education and experience to do such work as follows:

The basic findings of the above work are as follows: Geochemical anomalies in gold, silver and arsenic were detected throughout the area which was sampled. Most anomalies values appear to be associated with mineralized structures and do not form large coherent areas of anomalous ground. The anomalous mineralization is a good indication that hydrothermal fluids passed through this system carrying gold. There is potential for gold mineralization at depth in a reactive horizon. Targets are being considered for a drilling program to determine the mineral potential of the claims. The individual analyses, maps and interpretations are on file in the offices of Noranda Exploration, Inc., Reno, Nevada.

All of the aforesaid unpatented mining claims form one contiguous group of claims and work for the benefit of any one claim tends to develop all the claims. The work was performed for the purpose of developing the mineral potential of the claims and to maintain and hold such claims.
