Notwithsteading any provision of this lease to the contiary, any drilling, construction, or other operation on the leased lands that will disturb the surface therefor or otherwise affect the environment, hereinatter called "surface disturbing operation," conducted by lessee shall be subject, as set forth in this stipulation, to prior approval of such operation by the Area Oil and Gas Supervisor in consultation with appropriate surface management agency and to such resonable conditions, not inconsistent with the purposes for which this lease as issued, as the Supervisor may require to protect the surface of the leased lands and the environment.
