Box 152, Eureka, Nevada 89316, and Geneve Bisont, a citizen of the United States, whose mailing address is 2475-7 Sycamore Glen Drive, Sparks, Nevada 89434 (collectively, the "Locators"), by and through their agent have located and claims a Lode Mining claim on the property hereafter described, under and pursuant to the Mining Laws of the United States of America and the State of Nevada, and do hereby certify and declare:

1. The name of this claim is the Rat No. 32A Lode Mining Claim (the "Claim").

2. The Claim was located on the 10th day of January, 1990. The monumentation and marking of the corners of the Claim was completed on the 11th day of January, 1990.

3. The Locator claims 590 feet in a westerly direction along the lode, vein, ledge or deposit from the point of discovery, and 10 feet in a easterly direction, in all comprising 600 feet, linear and horizontal measurement, along the lode, vein, ledge or deposit, with all its dips, angles and variations, as allowed by law; together with 30 feet on each side of the middle of said vein, at the surface, so far as can be determined from present developments, in all 60 feet in width. The general course of the lode, vein, ledge or deposit, as near as may be determined, is from the east to the west.

4. The Claim is situated in the Eureka Mining District, County of Eureka and State of Nevada, and is described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit: Beginning at corner No. 1, the northeast corner, thence South 3° 00' East 60 feet to corner No. 2; thence South 87° 00' West 300 feet to corner No. 3; thence South 87° 00' West 300 feet to corner No. 4; thence North 3° 00' West 60 feet to corner No. 5; thence North 87° 00' East 300 feet to corner No. 6; thence North 87° 00' East 300 feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; posts or monuments have been placed at the center of each side line. The Claim is identified, located and tied by reference to the public land survey or claim location monument as follows: As calculated from information shown on Eureka County Map File No. 90273, the tie from "Claim corner marker SR-1" to the location monument of Rat No. 32A is N34°35'05"W., 6204.02 Ft.

5. The claims adjoining the Claim are: Selrat No. 48 Mining Claim to the west; Rat No. 17A Mining Claim to the east;

Rat No. 33 Mining Claim to the south; and Rat No. 32 Mining Claim to the north.

6. The unsurveyed land upon which the Claim is located, based upon a protracted United States Government grid, is: SE quarter of Section 21, Township 18N Range 53E of the Mount Diablo Principal Meridian.

7. The location work consisted of preparing the claim map required by N.R.S. 517.040, the original of which is attached hereto, which map is prepared from an actual field survey with courses and distances of the boundary line, and references to a claim location monument by which the location of the claim on the ground can be readily and accurately ascertained. Two copies of the map have been filed with the Eureka County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the Eureka County Recorder. All corner and side monuments are constructed of 3"x5" PVC post and identified by metal tags inscribed with the appropriate number.

8. The said claim is a new location and not a relocation, although the said claim covers portions of the same ground included in a defective or abandoned claim known as Rat No. 32, NMC No. 26571, the location certificate for which was recorded on August 5, 1978 in the office of the Eureka County Recorder at Book 65, Page 191, which was relocated as Rat No. 32, NMC No. 366358, by Amselco Exploration Inc., the relocation certificate for which was recorded on May 12, 1986 in the office of the Eureka County Recorder in Book 144, Page 239.
