Ruby Hill Mining Company caused to be made and performed on or for the benefit of said claims, the annual labor and improvements required by the laws of the United States and the State of Nevada, which work was done between October 1989 and August 1990 for the assessment year ending at 12:00 o'clock Meridian, September 1, 1990.

There was expended for said labor and improvements an amount in excess of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00+), and they were made at the expense of Ruby Hill Mining Company. The annual labor and improvements for said claims consisted of:

The dump areas of the Lawton, Richmond, Jackson, Phoenix, Bowman, Lookout and other mine areas were cleaned up with a D-8 bulldozer and contoured to more natural slopes. The Phoenix Adit, Lawton 100 Level Adit, Lawton 100 Waste Adit, Granite Tunnel, Roberts Tunnel, Charter Tunnel, Alblon Five Tunnel and Rogers Tunnel were opened with a dozer so they could be examined and sampled. Geologic mapping and sampling was done in various areas. The road to the Grant mine was improved and graded and various other roads were maintained. The work was done by employees of Project Glistler and Ruby Hill Mining Company.

The work was done on various claims including the Grant M.S. 73, Main Shaft M.S. 2864, Grand Central M.S. 174, Great Eastern M.S. 165, Alblon #2 M. S. 2861, Acouchment M.S. 2866, Buckeye M.S. 37, Surplus M.S. 85, Honeymoon Amended M.S. 2868, Adams and Farren M.S. 16, La Veta M.S. 2873, Bowman M.S. 175, Oriental and Belmont M.S. 196, General Lee M.S. 20, Margereta M.S. 1946, Jumbo No. 3, Ann No. 4, Jay No. 2, Alpha Extension, Alpha Extension #6, East Cyanide, Helen, Red Seal, Adams Hill, Mohawk and others.

The above named and described unpatented lode mining claims and adjoining patented lode mining claims comprise a contiguous group of lode mining claims owned in common by Ruby Hill Mining Company. The said labor was performed and improvements made for the

benefit of each and all of said mining claims comprising said contiguous group, as a part of a general plan of development and they tend to improve and develop each and all of said mining claims. The amount expended for the value of said labor and improvements is not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each of the mining claims comprising said contiguous group. The said expenditure was made in good faith for the purpose of developing said contiguous group of mining claims and was intended as annual labor and improvements for each and all of the above and described unpatented lode mining claims.
