GEOCHEMICAL RECONNAISSANCE OF THE "CAMP 1-4" CLAIM BLOCK

EUREKA COUNTY, NEVADA
by David Reid, U.S. Gold Corp.
August 24, 1990

The "Camp 1-4" unpatented lode claim block is located in Sections 25 & 26 of Township 24 North and Range 49 East, MDBM, Eureka County, Nevada (figure 1). Claim examination and geochemical sampling were conducted on this property during August, 1990.

A reconnaissance geochemical sampling program was conducted on the Camp 1-4 claim block by Ron Espell, Project Geologist, Tonkin Springs Gold Mining Company and under the direction of David Reid, (B.S. Geology, Ball State University), Senior Vice President of U.S. Gold Corporation. Samples were collected at various locations on the claims and are shown on figure 1. The medium of the soil samples collected was lower "B" horizon soils where possible. Samples were taken in this fashion to evaluate possible favorable structures and alteration.

Samples were delivered to the assay lab listed on the accompanying affidavit for analysis of gold and other pathfinder elements. Anomalous concentrations of these elements may indicate potential for the existence of precious metals deposits in the vicinity.

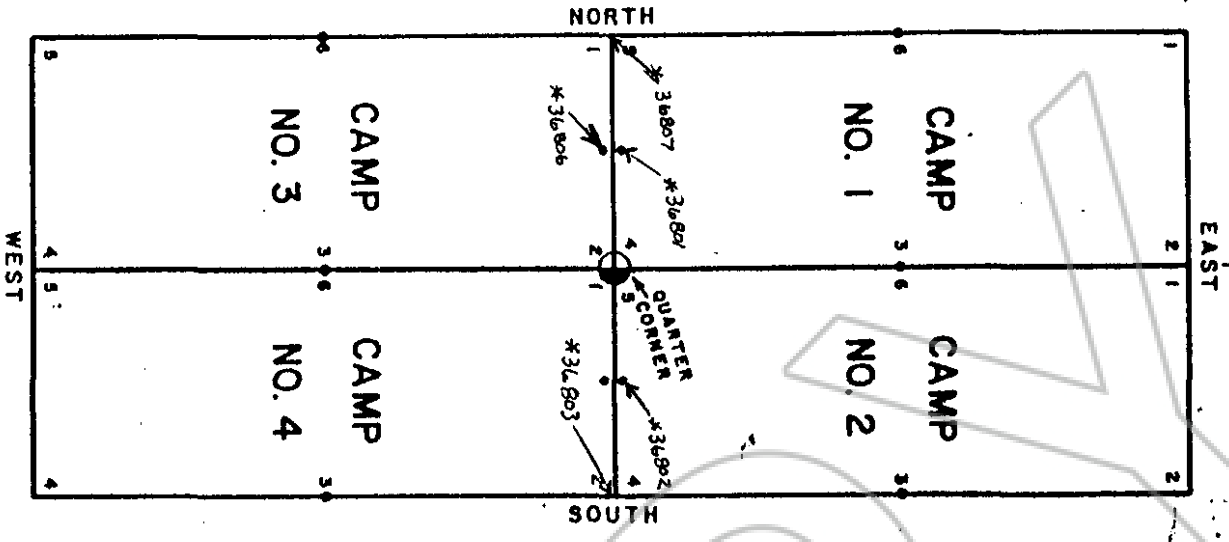

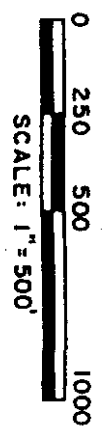
