# The United States of America,

Do all in whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Elko, Nevada,

accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that the Lynn Big Six Mining Company

has entered and paid for the Big Six No. 3 lode mining claim,

dedicated by the Surveyor General as Survey No. 4332, embracing a portion of, approximately,

Sections eleven and twelve in Township thirty-five north of Range fifty east of the Mount Diablo Meridian, in the Lynn Mining District, Bureau County, Nevada,

and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning at corner No. 1, a pine post six inches square, marked BS 3 - 1 - 4332, in mound of earth and stone, from which

U. S. Mineral Monument No. 292, bears north forty-three minutes east one thousand eight hundred seventy-three and twenty-four hundredths feet dis-

tant:

Thence, first course, with twenty-nine degrees fifty-eight min-

utes west seven hundred twenty-three and five-tenths feet to corner No. 2 a quartzite stone 6 x 12 x 24 inches, marked (X) at corner point and BS

3 - 2 - 4332, with mound of stone;

Thence, second course, with thirty-five degrees west seven hun-

dred seventy-eight feet to corner No. 3, a quartzite stone 6 x 12 x 26

inches, marked (X) at corner point and BS 3 - 3 - 4332, with mound of stone

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Thenoe, third course, south fifty-two degrees three minutes east three hundred one and thirty-three hundredths feet to a point from which location monument bears north thirty-two degrees thirty-four minutes east one thousand four hundred ninety-eight feet distant; six hundred two and sixty-six hundredths feet to corner No. 4, a quartzite stone 10 x 12 x 24 inches, marked a (X) at corner point and BS 3 - 4 - 4332, with mound of stone;

Thenoe, fourth course, north thirty-two degrees twenty-nine minutes thirty seconds east one thousand five hundred and two-tenths feet to corner No. 5, a pine post six inches square, two feet above mound of earth and stone, marked BS 3 - 5 - 4332;

Thenoe, fifth course, north fifty-two degrees three minutes west six hundred and six-tenths feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; said Survey No. 4332 extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along the Big Six No. 3 vein or lode; the premises herein granted, containing twenty and fifty-nine-thousandths acres.

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NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore, pursuant to the laws aforesaid, hereby granted by the United States unto the said

Lynn Big Six Mining Company

the said mining premises heretofore described, and not expressly excepted

from these presents, and all that portion of the said vein, lode, or ledge, and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges throughout their entire

depth, the tops or apices of which the inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said survey extended downward

partially, although such vein, lode, or ledge in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the

vertical side lines of said premises: Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said vein, lode, or ledge shall be

confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey so continued in their

own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said vein, lode, or ledge: And provided further, That nothing herein

contained shall authorize the grantee herein to enter upon the surface of a claim owned or possessed by another,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever

nature thereunto belonging, unto the said grantee above named and to **IT'S SUCCESSORS**

and assigns forever, subject, nevertheless, to the above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST: That the premises hereby granted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural,

manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and

acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way

thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

SECOND: That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of **NEVADA**

may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drains, and other necessary means to its

complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, **WOODROW WILSON**,

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made
