



SUMMARY REPORT

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the lode mining claims described in Exhibit A attached to this Affidavit.

The work consisted of geological analysis, an airborne geophysical survey (EM-Resistivity, Magnetics and VLF), and airphoto structural analysis. The conclusion of the work was that the claim block area is within a region of anomalous magnetic signature which indicates a deep structural zone related to known gold deposits of the region. Resistivity anomalies have also been identified and are considered drill targets located in Tertiary volcanic and Ordovician siliceous rocks.

The work was performed over the entire contiguous claim block for the benefit of all the claims. The amount of money expended for such labor is noted on the Affidavit.

The work was directed by Patrick C. Cavanaugh of 729 Aronson Avenue, Billings, Montana 59105. Mr. Cavanaugh is a geologist with 16 years of experience in exploration and a M.S. in geology from the University of Montana.
