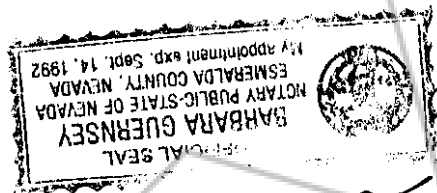

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A Detailed Geologic and Geophysical Evaluation

This report is submitted in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the contiguous group of certain unpatented lode mining claims known as the **Lone Mountain claim group**, which are described on the attached Proof of Labor and which are situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Under the direction of Tania M. Hansen, geologist for Combined Metals Reduction Company (CMR), CMR has been actively conducting geological examinations via electromagnetic geophysical surveys on the **Mountain View**, **Mountain View Extension**, **Mountain View 1** and **Mountain View 5** claims for the 1990 assessment year. Within the block geologic mapping and sampling has defined an area over which a subsequent geophysical survey was conducted to substantiate previously collected data. Electromagnetic soundings were taken every 50 feet along surveyed lines with a Geonics EM-16 geophysical instrument. The data was reduced and interpreted by CMR personnel.

The geophysical findings indicate favorable zones trending approximately N45E. Additional exploration procedures are being considered for this and other favorable trends within the claim block. Miss Hansen holds a Bachelors degree in geology from Whitman College, Washington, and has been active in exploration geology for two years.

All technical work, maps and reports are in the possession of and are considered to be the exclusive property of Combined Metals Reduction Company, the owner of the claims with offices at Fish Lake Valley, Tonopah, Nevada 89049, attention Mr. Jeremy Benezet, Land coordinator.
