SUMMARY REPORT FOR SAM PLACER CLAIMS

This report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28 - 1 for the Sam placer claims nos. 1 through 91, a contiguous group of mining claims situated in Section 5, the east 1/2 of Section 6, the east 1/2 of Section 7 and in Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 48 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Lander and Eureka Counties, Nevada.

The work completed consisted of trenching, sampling, assaying, metallurgical testing and resource estimations to determine the extent, tenor and metallurgical quality of the mineralization which exists on this claim group. This work was performed between September 1, 1989 and September 1, 1990 by employees of Cortez Gold Mines, located in Cortez, NV, under the direction of Timothy B. Dimock, a mine engineer with 2.5 years of experience in the mining industry and a Bachelor of Science degree in Mining Engineering, acquired in 1988 from the University of Utah, Salt Lake City, UT. The cost of the work completed exceeds \$9,100 and was paid for by Cortez Gold Mines, owner of said claims.

The results of the work completed on the Sam placer claims suggest that anomalous concentrations of gold and other metals exist, and that a potentially viable placer resource of precious metals exists which could be exploited by Cortez Gold Mines. The proprietary results of the work completed are in the possession of Cortez Gold Mines.

Additional exploration for similar occurrences of mineralization on the claim block, and additional testing on the known mineralization are recommended to determine optimum operating and milling parameters.
