SUMMARY REPORT FOR SALLY PLACER CLAIMS


This report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28 - 1 for the Sally placer claims nos. 1 through 35, a contiguous group of mining claims situated in the southeast 1/4 of Section 7, the west 1/2 of Section 8, the northwest 1/4 of Section 17 and the northeast 1/4 of Section 18, Township 26 North, Range 48 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Lander and Eureka Counties, Nevada.

The work completed consisted of mapping, systematic sampling, assaying and resource estimations to determine the extent and tenor of the mineralization which exists on this claim group. This work was performed between September 1, 1989 and September 1, 1990 by employees of Cortez Gold Mines, located in Cortez, NV. This work was completed under the direction of Stanley T. Foo, a mine geologist having 12 years of experience in the mineral exploration and mining industry and who holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Geology, acquired in 1978 from Hamilton College which is located in Clinton, New York. The cost of the work completed exceeds \$3,500 and was paid for by Cortez Gold Mines, owner of said claims.

The results of the work completed on the Sally placer claims suggest that anomalous concentrations of gold and other metals exist, and that a potentially viable placer resource of precious metals exists which could be exploited by Cortez Gold Mines. The proprietary results of the work completed are in the possession of Cortez Gold Mines.

Additional exploration for similar occurrences of mineralization on the claim block, and additional testing on the known mineralization are recommended to determine the metallurgical quality and true extent of the defined mineralized zone.
