4. That the above claims are located in Eureka County, Nevada, and are in Section 14, T33N, R50E, MDBM.

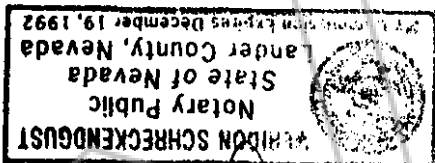
5. That the work consisted of a geochemical survey. A detailed report as required by Federal and Nevada mining law is attached as Appendix A and is made a part hereof.

Date(s) of work: August 1990

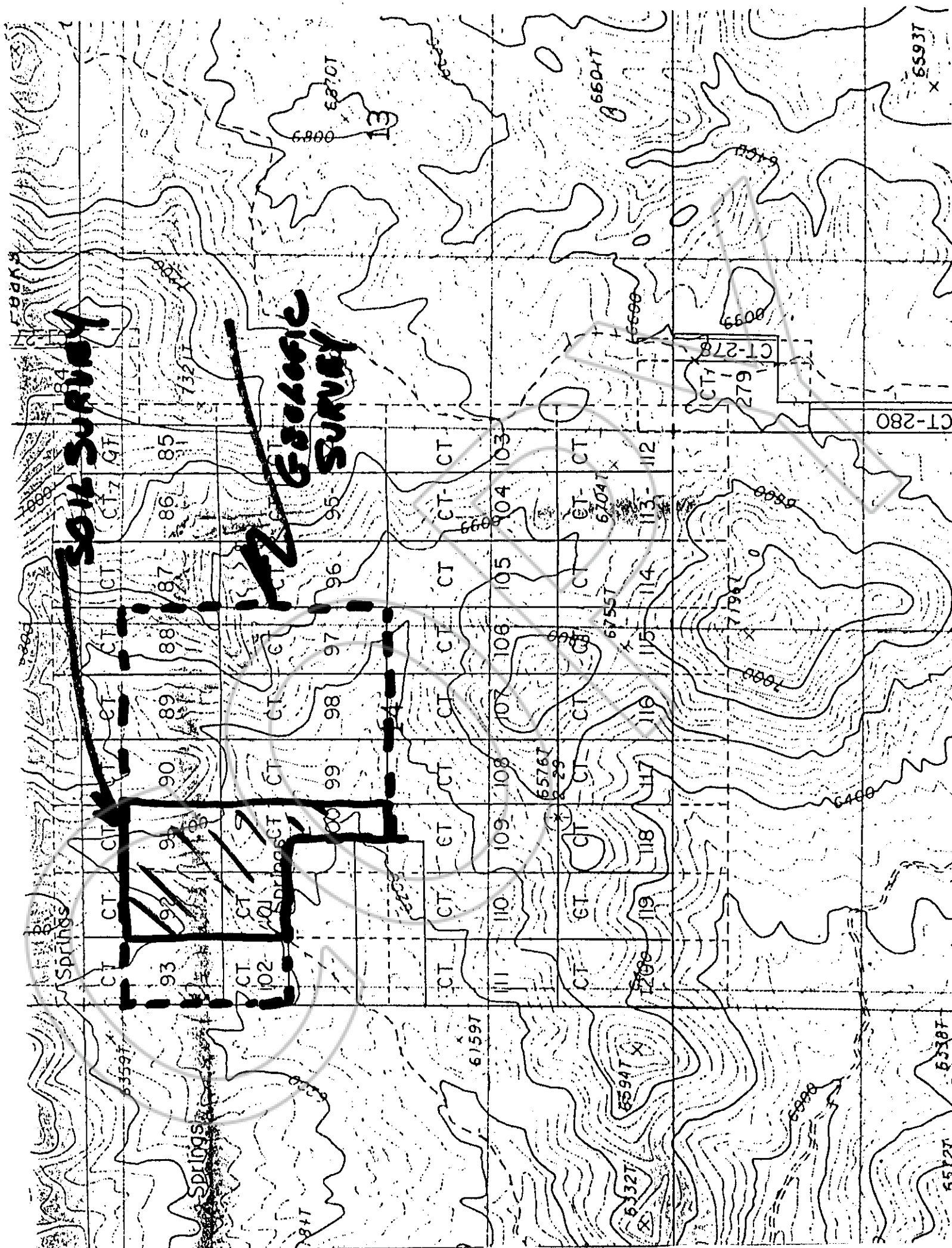
This report details the geochemical and geological survey undertaken as part of the development of the above claims on behalf of St. George Metals, Inc.. The attached map gives the location of the survey relative to the claim boundaries and location monuments. All work was conducted per the specifications of James A. McGlasson, Vice President of Exploration, St. George Metals, Inc., M.S. Geology, of 7387 Flower St., Littleton CO 80123, with over 20 years experience in exploration geology.

Field work was conducted by James S. Johnston (M.S. Geology), 9790 W. 88th Pl. Broomfield, CO 80021 and Andy Ruedi (B.S. Geology) 188 S. Zinnia Way Lakewood CO 80228.

Analyses were performed by Chemex Labs, Reno NV.

The soil sampling indicated an area of anomalous mercury concentration. The geological reconnaissance and soil sampling indicated areas to be further investigated by trenching and or drilling. Reconnaissance covered CT claims 88 through 93 and 97 through 102. The soil sampling was in CT claims 91, 92, 100, 101 per the attached map.
