

MEMORANDUM OF SITE OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Barrick Goldstrike Mines

Inc. ("Barrick"), the owner of the unpatented millsite claims described in Exhibit A hereto (the "Claims"), and Big Three Industrial Gas, Inc. ("Big Three") entered into that certain Site Occupancy Agreement dated as of July 2, 1990 (the "Agreement").

Barrick and Big Three by this Memorandum of Site Occupancy Agreement give notice of the existence of the Agreement. Under the terms of the Agreement, Big Three is authorized to exercise all possessory rights of Barrick in and to the Claims, insofar as the Claims are contained within the boundaries of Big Three's Plant Site, as described in Exhibit B hereto, for the purposes of constructing, operating and maintaining a 1,200 ton per day oxygen plant and liquid oxygen storage facilities relating thereto. The term of the Agreement coincides with the term of the Oxygen Supply Contract between Barrick and Big Three dated as of June 15, 1990, or any extensions thereof, unless terminated earlier as provided in the Agreement.

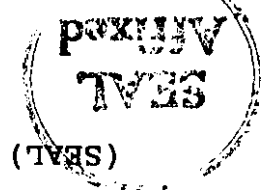

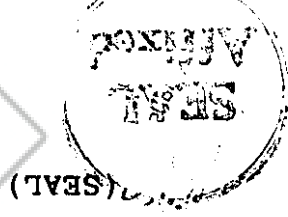
