## ASSIGNMENT OF MINING LEASE

No. 87-1066-JB captioned "Medard Schmitz and Hennes-Westex
Corporation, a Nevada corporation, Plaintiffs, v. Herbert Kuglmeier,
Defendant" (hereinafter "Lawsuit") entered a Judgment in favor of
Medard Schmitz and against Herbert Kuglmeier ordering Herbert
Kuglmeier to immediately convey any interest which he acquired from
Hennes-Westex in the Mining Lease to Medard Schmitz, individually, and

Drawer AA, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87103, and James E. Kirk, 11927 Menaul N.E., Suite #201, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87112 an undivided 1/3 interest in and to any interest Medard Schmitz and Martha True Schmitz, his wife, have or hereafter acquire in the Mining Lease.
