## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to psy the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or essessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition therelo) shall be a ilen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property; whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien Imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assertsment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so issed (or a judgement against the taipayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

## Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgement Lien Creditors. - The Ilen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgement tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

## (n) Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(I) Place For Filing - The notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be filed - (A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in

which the property subject to the lien is situated; and (ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the country, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the flen is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in whic the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated .

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a

PERFECTIONS FOR (1) General Rule. - Unless notice of Ren is refiled in the menner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of liev shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) PISCE FOR FIlling. - A notice of lien reliled during the required reliling period shall be effective only -

(I) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of Hen was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (1) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the data of a reliling of notice of Hen under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period. - In the case any notice of lien, the term "required reflling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (8) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of tien.

Sec. 6325. Release Lien Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall lesse a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (includ extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Mary and Anthroposes.

> (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding item. - If a notice of lien has been likel pursuant to section 6223(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
