3. That the above claims are owned by R. D. Damele and leased by Pathfinder Exploration Corporation, and that said claims are contiguous and have been consolidated into one group with other claims held by Pathfinder for the purpose of common development.

4. That the work consisted of rock chip sampling, BLEG stream sediment geochemistry, and geologic type work. For compliance with the requirements of Title 30 United States Code 28-1, the following summary report is filed relating to geological type work.

The work performed during July and August 1991 consisted of detailed geological and geochemical surveys performed by Michael Coleman, David Fitch, and Michael Turner; consulting and staff geologists for Pathfinder Exploration Corporation. The personnel are all geologists holding degrees in geology from accredited universities; each with in excess of 15 years experience in the Mining Industry.

The cost of the geological and geochemical studies, together with the physical work completed, exceeds \$6,000. The basic findings of the study are as follows:

Excessive zones of argillized, sandstone, and silicified carbonates are cut by numerous high angle faults. These carbonates contain visible stibnite, barite, and extensive jasperoids. Sampling within this environment has delineated several zones containing anomalous concentrations of gold, arsenic, and antimony that will be further studied to help determine the presence of economic concentrations of gold.

These studies enhance knowledge of the controls to mineralization in the area, thereby providing and encouraging a more informed base for further exploration and development for an economic mineralized deposit.

All technical work and results are in the possession of and are considered to be the exclusive property of Pathfinder Exploration.
