MEMORANDUM OF VENTURE AGREEMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that HIGH DESERT MINERAL RESOURCES OF NEVADA, INC., a Nevada corporation ("High Desert"), whose address is P.O. Box 2008, Elko, Nevada 89801, and NEWMONT GOLD COMPANY, a Delaware corporation ("Newmont"), whose address is One United Bank Center, 1700 Lincoln Street, Denver, Colorado 80203, have entered into the Newmont Gold and High Desert Venture Agreement dated as of December 23, 1991 (the "Venture Agreement").

Pursuant to the Venture Agreement, High Desert has contributed to the purposes of the Venture Agreement an undivided 40% interest and Newmont has contributed thereto an undivided 60% interest in (i) the patented and unpatented mining claims, leasehold interests, water rights, contract rights and samples, data and information identified in Exhibit A hereto (the "High Desert Properties"), and (ii) the unpatented mining claims identified in Exhibit B hereto, to the extent such mining claims include land which is also included within the boundaries of any of the unpatented mining claims identified in Exhibit A hereto (such mining claims identified in Exhibit B, only to the extent they include such land, are hereinafter referred to as the "Newmont Claims") (the High Desert Properties and the Newmont Claims are hereinafter referred to as the "Properties"), and High Desert and Newmont have agreed to participate in the exploration, evaluation and development of mineral resources within the Properties or any other properties acquired under the terms of the Venture Agreement.

High Desert acquired its 40% interest in the Newmont Claims and Newmont acquired its 60% interest in the High Desert Properties pursuant to the following instruments, each dated as of December 23, 1991:

- (a) Quitclaim Deed and Assignment from High Desert to Newmont;
- (b) Special Warranty Deed from High Desert to Newmont;
- (c) Assignment from High Desert to Newmont;
- (d) Assignment and Bill of Sale from High Desert to Newmont; and
- (e) Special Warranty Deed from Newmont to High Desert.

The respective interests in the Properties conveyed to High Desert and Newmont pursuant to these instruments were conveyed subject to the obligation of High Desert and Newmont to contribute such interests to the Newmont Gold and High Desert Venture, pursuant to the Venture Agreement, and such interests were conveyed prior to the contribution of such interests to the Newmont Gold and High Desert Venture.

Pursuant to Section 5.2 of the Venture Agreement, Newmont's failure to make its Initial Contribution (as defined in the Venture Agreement) in accordance with the provisions of Sections 5.1, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.5 thereof shall be deemed to be a withdrawal of Newmont from the Venture Agreement and the termination of its Participating Interest (as defined in the Venture Agreement), including its interest in the Properties, subject to Newmont's right to cure such failure as provided in the Venture Agreement and except for Newmont's interest in any Project Area (as defined in the Venture Agreement) established prior to such failure.

Pursuant to Section 2.4 of the Venture Agreement, title to the Properties shall be held by High Desert and Newmont as tenants in common with ownership equal to their respective Participating Interests. Pursuant to Section 6.1 of the Venture Agreement, High Desert's initial Participating Interest is 40% and Newmont's initial Participating Interest is 60%.

Pursuant to Section 3.2 of the Venture Agreement, venture operations shall be conducted in the name of the venture. Pursuant to a Fictitious Name Certificate dated as of December 23, 1991, High Desert and Newmont have given notice of their intention to do business under the name of the "Newmont Gold and High Desert Venture."

Pursuant to Section 4.1 of the Venture Agreement, nothing contained in the Venture Agreement constitutes either High Desert or Newmont the partner of the other, nor, except as expressly provided in the Venture Agreement, constitutes either High Desert or Newmont the agent or legal representative of the other, nor does anything contained in the Venture Agreement create any fiduciary relationship between High Desert and Newmont. Section 4.1 further provides that it is not the intention of High Desert and Newmont to create, nor shall the Venture Agreement be construed to create, any mining, commercial, or other partnership, and that neither High Desert nor Newmont shall have any authority to act for or assume any obligation or responsibility on behalf of the other, except as expressly provided in the Venture Agreement. Section 4.1 further provides that the rights,

duties, obligations and liabilities of High Desert and Newmont shall be several and not joint or collective, and that High Desert and Newmont shall be responsible only for their respective obligations as set out in the Venture Agreement and shall be liable only for their respective share of the costs and expenses as provided in the Venture Agreement, it being the express purpose and intention of High Desert and Newmont that their ownership of assets and the rights acquired under the Venture Agreement shall be as tenants in common.

Copies of the Venture Agreement are in the possession of High Desert and Newmont at their respective addresses listed above.




