MEMORANDUM OF

MINING LEASE WITH OPTION TO PURCHASE

This Memorandum of Mining Lease with Option to Purchase (the "Memorandum"), dated effective as of February 21, 1992, is by and between ROCKY CANYON MINING COMPANY, 1675 Broadway, Suite 2460, Denver, Colorado 80202 ("RCMC") and BARRICK GOLD EXPLORATION INC., 790 Commercial Street, Elko, Nevada 89801 ("Barrick").

RECITALS

- A. In accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in that certain Mining Lease with Option to Purchase (the "Lease and Option"), dated effective as of the date first above written, RCMC has leased to Barrick the exclusive right to enter, explore and develop the lands described in Exhibit "A" to this Memorandum (the "Property") and the option to purchase the royalty interest reserved by RCMC under the Lease and Option.
- B. RCMC and Barrick desire to create actual and record notice of the Lease and Option by recording this Memorandum in the real property records of Eureka County, Nevada.

AGREEMENT

- 1. Grant Of Rights. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, RCMC has leased and hereby leases the Property to Barrick on the terms and conditions set out in the Lease and Option. Pursuant to the Lease and Option, Barrick shall have:
- (a) The exclusive right to explore, prospect, develop, mine and extract, whether by underground, surface, soulution mining or other methods, any and all metals, ores, minerals, mineral substances and materials of all kinds in, under, upon and that may be produced from the Property, including all dump ores, concentrates and precipitates (which, collectively, are hereinafter referred to as "Products") and to store, stockpile, remove, ship, treat, process, sell and dispose of Products;
- (b) The exclusive right to carry on general mining, milling and/or refining operations pertaining to the Property or to other property owned or controlled by Barrick on the surface of, or through underground or surface mining operations on the Property or on other property owned or controlled by Barrick;

- (c) The exclusive right to construct, use and maintain in or upon the Property and the surface thereof such structures, mining machinery, equipment, tools, ore bins, roads, shafts, inclines, tunnels, drifts, open pits, leach pads, tailings ponds, pipelines, telephone lines, electric transmission lines, water storage and transmission facilities and pipelines, concentrating, milling or refining facilities, buildings, shops and other facilities as Barrick may deem necessary for Operations;
- (d) The exclusive right to use any surface and underground water and water rights now existing or subsequently discovered or developed in or upon or appurtenant to the Property and to use all reciprocal rights which the Property may have with respect to other properties in the area;
- (e) The right to commingle ore produced from the Property with ore from other properties; and
- (f) The right to do all things which are incidental to or which may be useful, desirable or convenient in Barrick's exercise of any or all of the rights granted to Barrick.
- 2. Reservation of Production Royalty. RCMC has reserved and hereby reserves and Barrick has agreed to pay and hereby agrees to pay to RCMC a royalty equal to 2.0% of Net Smelter Returns on all Products produced from the Property.
- 3. Grant of Option to Purchase. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, RCMC has granted and hereby grants to Barrick the exclusive right to purchase its retained 2% Net Smelter Returns royalty interest (the "Option to Purchase"), together with all rights, privileges and appurtenances incident to, pertaining to or connected with the Property, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Lease and Option. The Option to Purchase may be exercised by Barrick at any time during the term of the Lease and Option. The Option to Purchase may be exercised by Barrick as to one-half of the royalty prior to the third and fifth anniversary dates of the Lease and Option.
- 4. Term. The term of the Lease and Option begins on the effective date of the Lease and Option and continues for 15 years and so long as Barrick is actually engaged in Operations on the Property, unless sooner terminated or unless the Option to Purchase is exercised.
- 5. <u>Termination</u>. Barrick may terminate the Lease and Option at any time by 15 days' prior written notice to RCMC or by exercise of the Option to Purchase with respect to all of RCMC's interest in the Property.

- 6. <u>Assignment</u>. The Lease and Option may be assigned by either party only with the consent of the other, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld; provided, however, that either party may freely assign its rights under the agreement to an employee, a parent corporation or a wholly owned subsidiary or to a joint venture or subsidiary in which it has a controlling interest.
- 7. Area of Interest. The Lease and Option includes an area of interest provision which is defined as the exterior perimeter of the Property.

8. <u>Controlling Document</u>.

- (a) This Memorandum is made for the purpose of giving actual and record notice of the Lease and Option. A copy of the Lease and Option may be found at the offices of the parties at the addresses set forth above.
- (b) In the event of any inconsistency between this Memorandum and the Lease and Option, the Lease and Option shall control. The execution and recordation of this Memorandum shall not modify, amend, extinguish or supersede or in any other manner affect the rights and responsibilities of the parties under the Lease and Option.
- (c) Capitalized terms used in this Memorandum shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Lease and Option.
