TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the Second Party, Their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.

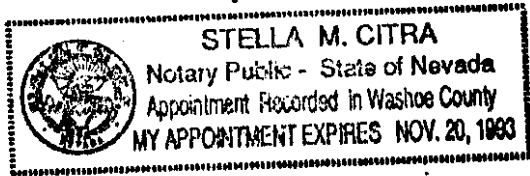
