AFFIDAVIT OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENT WORK

Assessment work on the LOR lode claims consisted of: Detailed geologic mapping, geochemical sampling, and hand trenching.

The work described above was performed at the following locations: LOR 50-79 (over the entire claim block). Hand trenching was confined to LOR 53.

The findings of the above work are as follows: Upperplate cherts and thin limestone units within the Valmey Formation, with areas of silicification along faults. Anomalous values of gold and silver were found associated with these zones.
