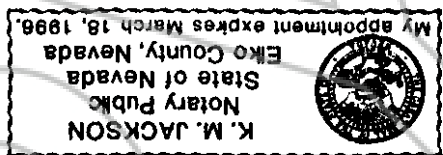

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirement of Title 30, United States Code, section 28-1 for the TS 95-108 and TS 118-124 contiguous unpatented claims, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

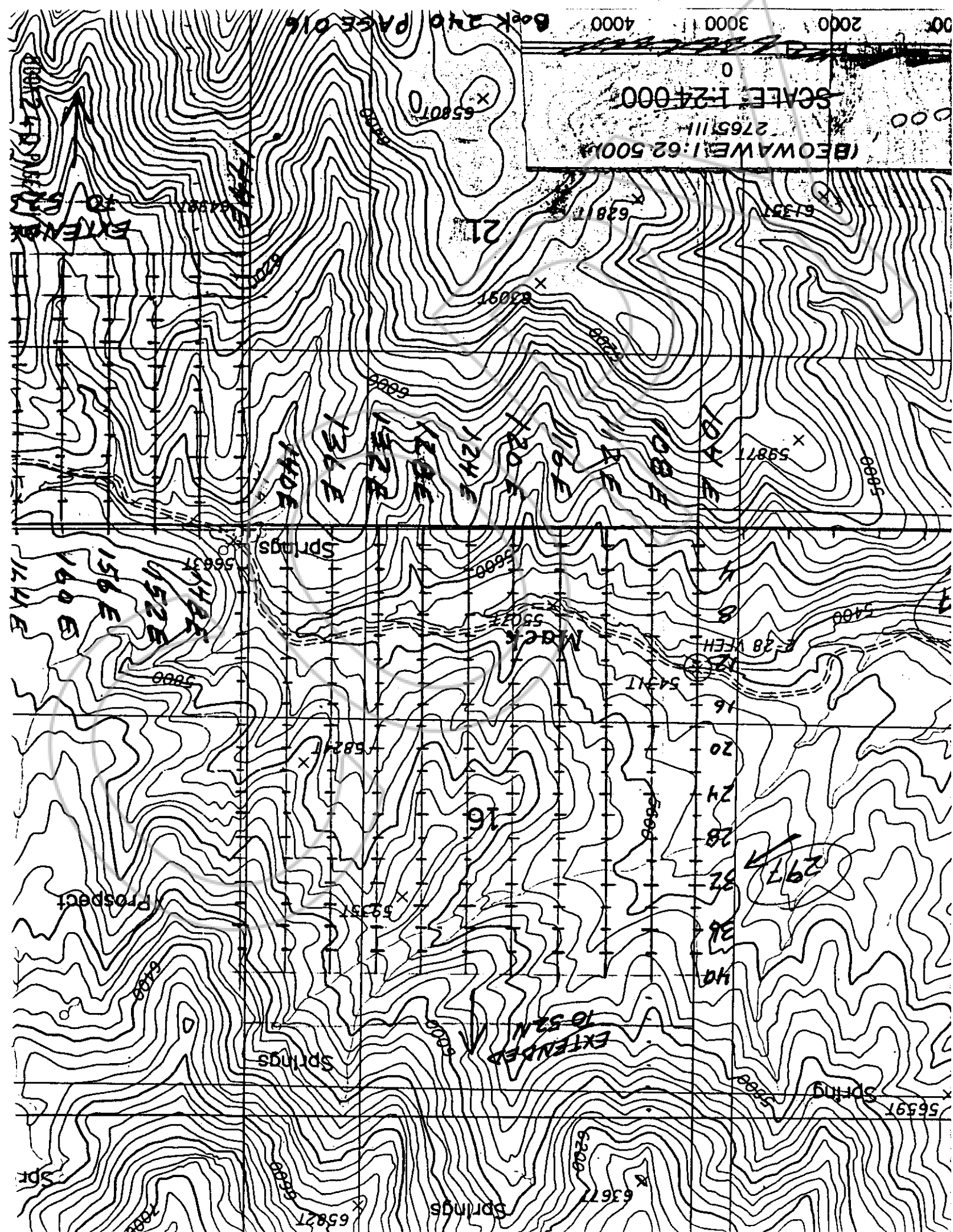
The assessment work consisted of a geochemical soil survey to evaluate the potential of the claims for discovery of valuable mineral deposits thereon and to assist in planning further exploration, development, and extraction of minerals. The work was supervised by Brian Arkell of Elko, Nevada, a professional geologist employed by Newmont Exploration Limited, P.O. Box 669, Carlin, Nevada 89822. Mr. Arkell has a Masters of Science degree in Geology from the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology and a Bachelor of Science degree in Geological Engineering from the University of Maryland. He has 8 years of experience in mining and mineral exploration. The sampling was performed by T & T Exploration Services, 236 Stewart Street, Reno, Nevada 89501, under contract to Newmont Exploration Ltd. T & T Exploration Services specializes in claim staking and geochemical sampling for the minerals industry.

The geochemical work consisted of 253 soil samples on a 200 x 400-foot grid, assayed by Chemex Labs. in Sparks, Nevada, for gold, silver, arsenic, antimony, mercury, lead, zinc and bismuth. The labor and analytical costs, totaling \$8,496, were paid by Newmont Exploration Ltd.

Soil assays range as follows:

gold	3 to 75 ppb
silver	0.1 to 0.9 ppm
arsenic	1 to 34 ppm
mercury	10 to 330 ppb
antimony	.02 to 15.6 ppm
copper	12 to 165 ppm
lead	2 to 40 ppm
zinc	7 to 1200 ppm
bismuth	0.1 to 1 ppm

All technical work and results are in the possession of Newmont Exploration Limited, the owner of the subject claims.
