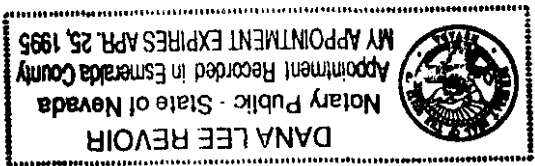

A Detailed Geologic Evaluation

This report is submitted in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the contiguous group of certain unpatented lode mining claims known as the Lone Mountain claim group, which are described on the attached proof of labor and which are situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Under the direction of Clyde Boyer, geologist for Combined Metals Reduction Company (CMR), CMR has been actively conducting geological examinations on the Mountain View Extension, Mountain View 1 and Mountain View 5 claims for the 1992 assessment year. Within the block geologic mapping and sampling has defined a favorable mineralized zone trending N45E that corresponds to a RM geophysical anomaly that was defined previously.

Additional exploration procedures are being considered for this and other favorable trends within the claim block.

Mr. Boyer holds a Bachelors of Science degree in geology from Montana State University, Bozeman Montana, and has been active in exploration and mine geology for over fourteen years.
