SUMMARY REPORT

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the lode mining claims described in Exhibit A attached to this Affidavit.

The work consisted of geological mapping at a scale of 1"=2000', rock chip geochemical sampling, geochemical analyses, drilling, and geochemical analyses of drill cuttings. The conclusion of the work was that covered gold mineralization is likely present on the western margin of the claim block. The mapping indicates a NW-SE trending structure is present on the property which could host economic gold mineralization. Some anomalous gold occurs in the samples.

The work was performed over the entire contiguous claim block for the benefit of all the claims. The amount of money expended for such labor is noted on the Affidavit.

The work was directed by Patrick C. Cavanaugh of 729 Aronson Ave, Billings, Montana 59105. Mr. Cavanaugh is a geologist with 18 years of experience in exploration and a Master of Science degree in geology from the University of Montana.
