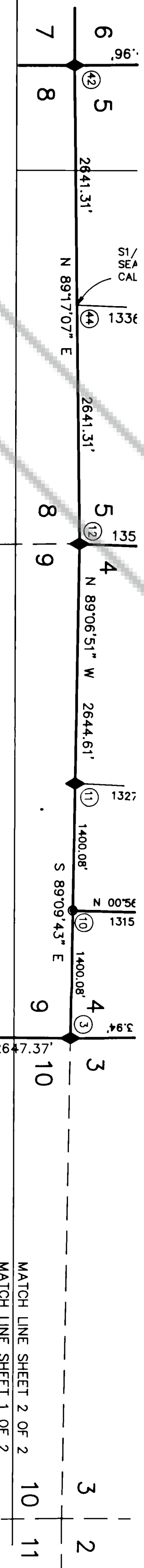
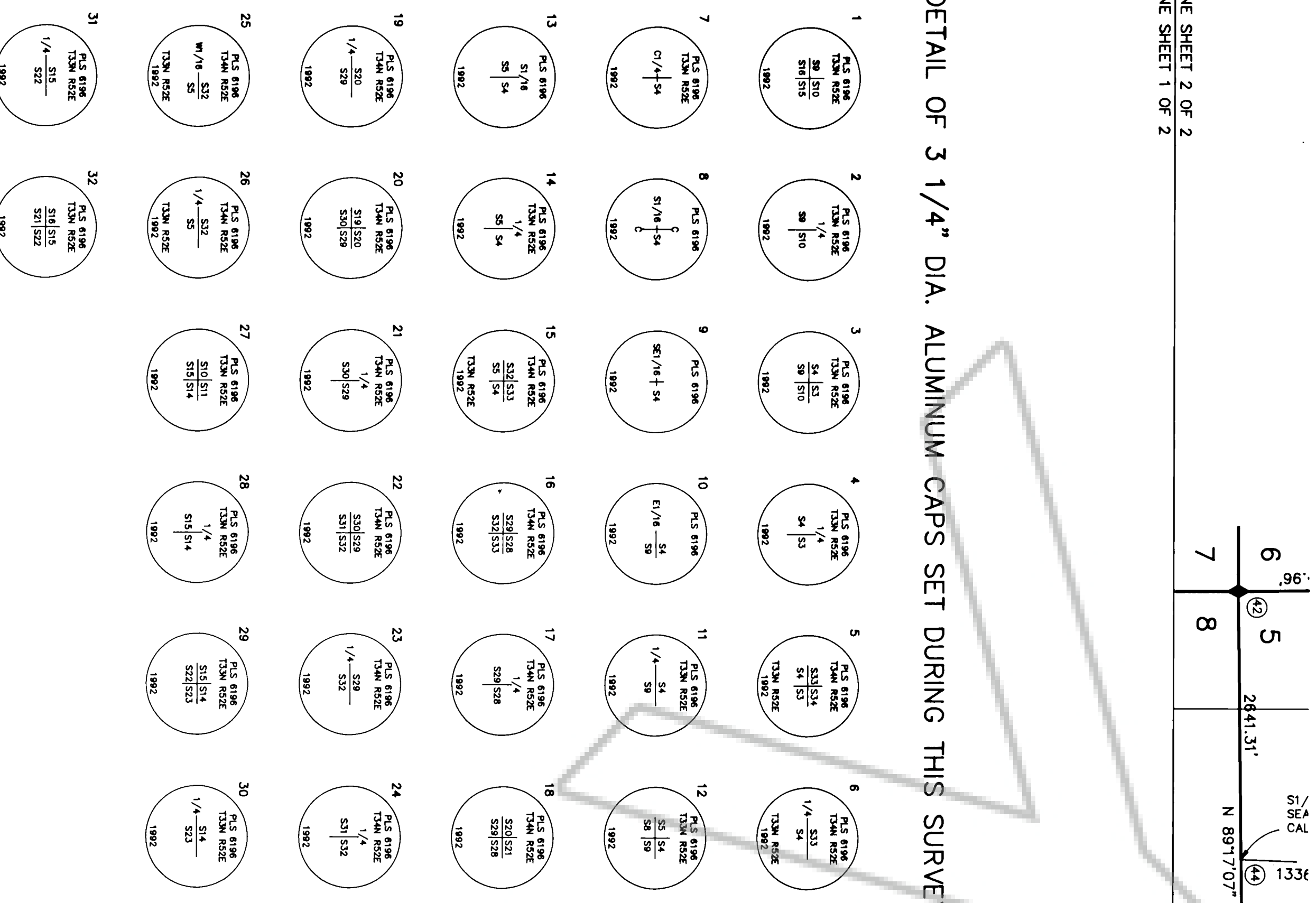


DETAIL OF 3 1/4" DIA. ALUMINIUM CAPS SET DURING THIS SURVEY



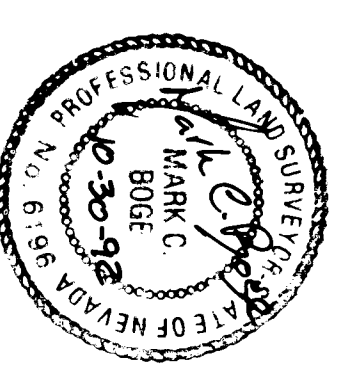

In recent years the original survey plat has been reviewed during the survey process and the record evidence has been reviewed during the survey process.

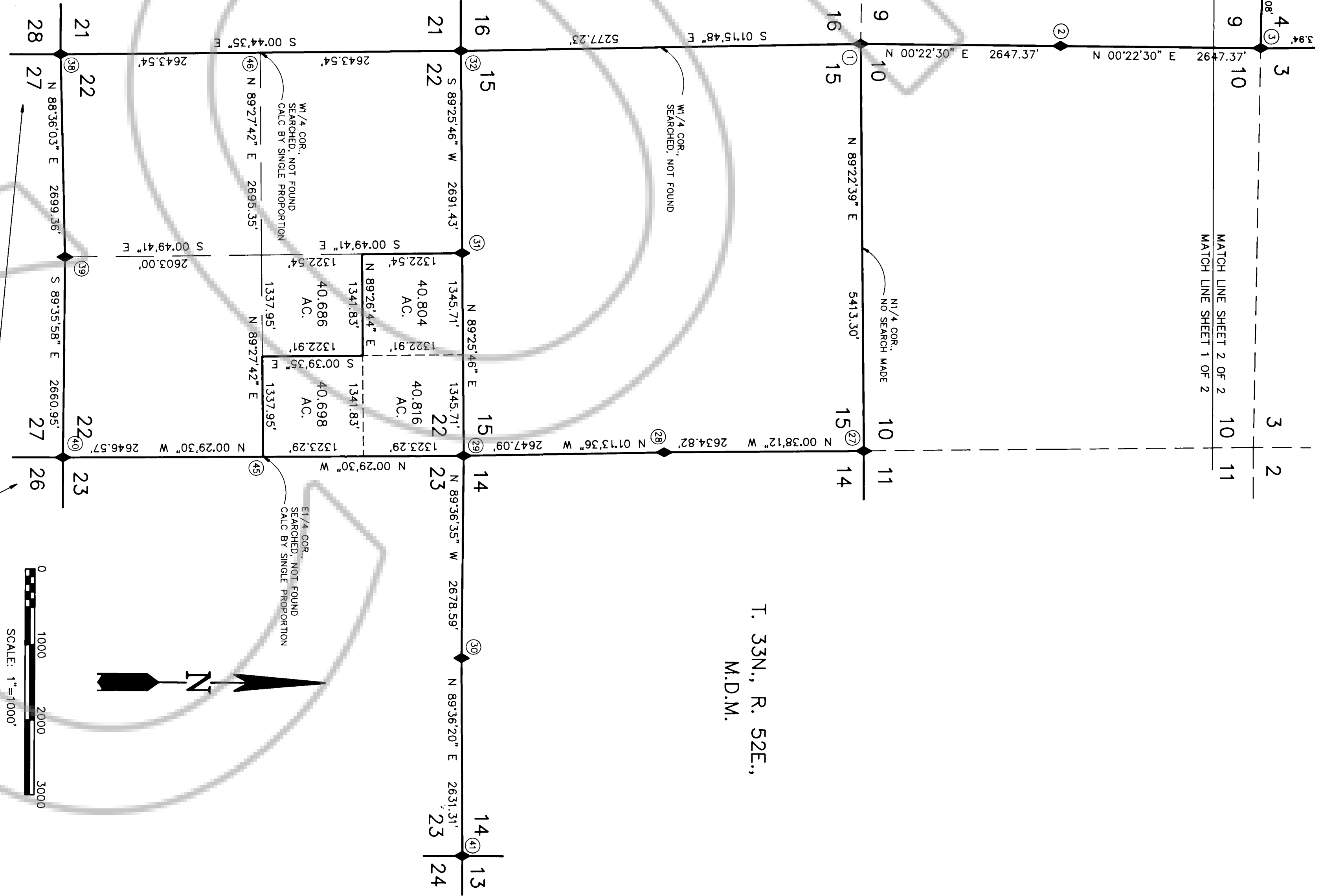

SURVEY EQUIPMENT AND ACCURACY

This survey was made with Electronic Total Station equipment of Leica-Topcon and Wild Manufacture. The horizontal and vertical distances were measured to the nearest one hundredth of a foot.

The survey shown on this map is based on the existing Newmont Gold Mine Survey. The survey was performed under the supervision and control of the Surveyor. The survey was completed on July 10, 1992. Each control traverse was closed upon itself to an accuracy of at least one part in fifty thousand. The stakes to land corners were set in concrete. The distances were measured from the established control points.
