The claim is approximately 1450 feet long and 540 feet wide, such that 10 feet is claimed in a NORTHWESTLY direction and 1440 feet in an SOUTHWESTLY direction from the point of discovery (monument of location), at which the Notice of location was posted, together with 270 feet on each side of the monument of location and center line of the Claim. The general course of the lode or vein is NORTH and SOUTH.
