The Trustee has brought suit under the fraudulent conveyance statutes of the States of Mississippi, Texas, Arkansas, Oklahoma, and Nevada and the Racketeering Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act, 18 U.S.C. § 1961 et seq. alleging that the oil, gas and mineral interests described in Exhibit "A" were acquired by Christopher P. Alford as a result of a criminal enterprise and that they were held in constructive trust for the Debtors in the above-referenced bankruptcy proceedings. Furthermore, said Christopher P. Alford fraudulently conveyed said interests to Denise Alford, his wife, in order to evade his creditors and the Plaintiff herein. The Trustee seeks to impose a constructive trust on the mineral interests held by Denise Alford on behalf of the Estates of Petro-Serve, Ltd. and Magnolia Development Corp. under the terms of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1961 et seq. and other applicable statutes.
