The court orders that an interlocutory judgment be entered declaring that the parties are entitled to have their marriage dissolved. This interlocutory judgment does not constitute a final dissolution of marriage and the parties are still married and will be, and neither party may remarry, until a final judgment of dissolution is entered.

The court also orders that, unless both parties file their consent to a dismissal of this proceeding, a final judgment of dissolution be entered upon proper application of either party or on the court's own motion after the expiration of at least six months from the date the court acquired jurisdiction of the respondent. MARITAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

I, Tommy Daryl Little, Husband, and I, Robin Lee Little, Wife, agree as follows:

We are now husband and wife. We were married on June 28, 1964, and separated on July 7, 1974. We make this agreement with reference to the following facts:

A. There are the following minor children of the parties:

Keith Arlo Little	September 30, 1958
Michelle Little	July 14, 1961
Stuart Wayne Little	February 24, 1968

B. Unhappy and irreconcilable differences have arisen between us which have caused the irretrievable breakdown of our marriage, wherefore we now desire to settle our mutual rights and duties as follows hereafter in detail.

We agree to live separately and apart, and, except for the duties and obligations imposed and assumed under this agreement, each shall be free from interference and control of the other as fully as if he or she were single. We each agree not to molest, interfere with or harass the other.

The wife shall have the care, custody and control of the minor children of the parties, subject to the right of the other spouse to visit said children at reasonable times and places.

Subject to the power of the court to modify the same, Tommy Daryl Little shall pay to Robin Lee Little, as and for child support, the sum of \$108.00 per month per child, a total of \$324.00 per month, payable on the 20th day of each month, beginning the 20th day of September, 1974, and continuing for each child until said child dies, marries, becomes self-supporting, or reaches the age of 18, whichever occurs first.

In addition, during the term of the support obligation for each child, Tommy Daryl Little shall carry and maintain medical, hospital and dental insurance for the benefit of said child as long as such policies are available through his means of employment.

In consideration of the other terms of this agreement, Husband agrees to pay Wife the sum of \$1.00 per month, payable on the 20th day of each month, beginning the 20th day of September, 1974, and continuing until five years from the date of the agreement or the wife's remarriage, whichever shall occur first.

Husband and wife agree that they have already divided their property to their mutual satisfaction, as stated below, and each hereby transfers and guarantees to the other any and all interest in any property in the possession of the other, and agrees that whatever property the other may possess is now the sole and separate property of the other.

Tommy Daryl Little shall become the sole owner of the following:

Robin Lee Little shall become the sole owner of the following:
House and property - 6280 Posey Lane, Paradise household goods and furnishings
1969 Chevy Suburban
Garden tools, mower and rototiller
Winchester 32 Special rifle
all California teacher retirement benefits

Husband shall pay the following debts, and indemnify and hold the wife harmless therefrom:

Balance owing on Nevada property
1974 loan from Beneficial Finance
Taxes on all previously listed property
Insurance on all previously listed property

Wife shall pay the following debts, and indemnify and hold the husband harmless therefrom:

Balance owing on Posey Lane property
Loans from California Teachers Association and Teachers' Aid and Retirement System
Balance due on Sears Account
Balance due on MasterCard Account
Taxes on all previously listed property
Insurance on all previously listed property

Husband and wife each promise the other that they shall not incur any debt or obligation for which the other may be liable, and each agrees that if any claim be brought seeking to hold the other liable for the subsequent debts of the other, or for act or omission, then each will hold the other harmless, and defend such claim.

The parties agree that: any tax refunds for the current fiscal year shall be distributed as follows: divided equally between the parties.
Any deficiencies for the current year shall be paid as follows: divided equally between the parties.

Each party agrees to execute and deliver any documents, make all endorsements, and do all acts which are necessary or convenient to carry out the terms of this agreement.

In the event of a dissolution proceeding, this agreement shall be submitted to the court for approval and incorporation into the decree, and the parties shall, by the terms of the decree, be ordered to comply with all terms of this agreement.

Each party has made a full disclosure to the other of his current finances and assets, and each enters into this agreement in reliance thereon.

This agreement, and each provision thereof, is expressly made binding upon the heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, representatives and successors in interest of each party.

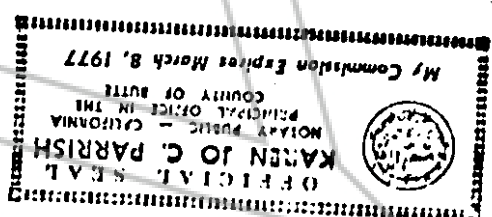

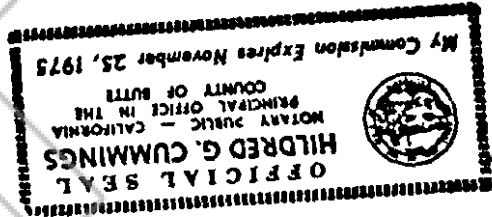
