THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS PRECIOUS METALS INC., by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the GP 75 Lode Mining Claim on this 16th day of March, 19 94, situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the SE(SW) (Quarter) Section(s) 25(25), Township 24 North, Range 50 East, Mt. Diablo P.M., and is more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

Thence, 600 feet in a south direction to Post No. 2, marked - GP 75 -2
Thence, 1500 feet in a west direction to Post No. 3, marked - GP 75 -3
Thence, 600 feet in a north direction to Post No. 4, marked - GP 75 -4
Thence, 1500 feet in an east direction to Post No. 1, marked - GP 75 -1

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein from the point of discovery is 20 feet in an east direction and 1480 feet in a west direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode for the entire length of the claim.
