DECREE OF DIVORCE

PRENTISS JACK BLACK and JOYCE ADELE BLACK, Husband and

wife, having filed herein on July 12, 1994, their joint petition,  
under oath, for a Decree of Divorce, pursuant to Chapter 125 of  
Nevada Revised Statutes, and neither party having filed herein any  
Notice of Revocation or other withdrawal of said joint petition,  
and good cause appearing therefore, the court finds from the  
verified joint petition as follows:

1. The court finds that all of the allegations of the  
joint petition are true and correct, and that said petition  
complies with all of the requirements of Nevada Revised Statutes  
Sections 125.181 to 125.184, pertaining to summary procedures for  
divorce.

2. The court finds that for a period of more than six

1 (6) weeks immediately preceding the commencement of this proceeding  
 2 the parties, and each of them, have been, and were at the time of  
 3 filing said joint petition, actual bona fide residents of the  
 4 County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and have been for said period  
 5 of time actually, physically and corporally present in said state,  
 6 and domiciled therein.

7 3. That the parties intermarried in Reno, Nevada, on  
 8 December 4, 1985, and ever since that time have been and now are  
 9 husband and wife.

10 4. That there are no minor children born the issue of  
 11 the marriage, nor adopted during the marriage and no children are  
 12 expected.

13 5. That on March 23, 1993, the parties entered into a  
 14 written Separation Agreement concerning their property rights and  
 15 dividing all joint or community property theretofore owned by them,  
 16 and providing for the payment and assumption of all joint or  
 17 community liabilities or obligations, which Separation Agreement  
 18 was attached to said joint petition. That said Separation  
 19 Agreement is fair and equitable, and that the parties have executed  
 20 all deeds, title certificates, or other documents necessary to  
 21 effectuate said Separation Agreement.

22 6. That the parties have waived any rights to spousal  
 23 support, and have also waived any right that they, or either of  
 24 them, may have to written notice of entry of the Decree of Divorce,  
 25 to appeal, to request findings of fact and conclusions of law, or  
 26 to move for a new trial.

1 That the parties are incompatible in marriage, and

2 desire the court to enter a Decree of Divorce.

3 8. That the wife has elected to resume the use of her

4 former name, to-wit: JOYCE ADELE MEHNER.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY

6 ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that PRENTISS JACK BLACK and JOYCE

7 ADELE BLACK be, and they hereby are, awarded a Judgment and Decree

8 of Divorce, forever dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore

9 and now existing between the said parties, and restoring to each

10 of said parties the status of an unmarried person.

11 IT IS ORDERED that all physical property belonging to the

12 parties, the existence of which is known to both parties, which is

13 not specifically divided between the parties by this order or

14 written Separation Agreement incorporated herein, shall become the

15 separate property of that person in possession of said property

16 together with any associated debts, at the time of entry of this

17 order.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if property belonging to the

19 parties the existence of which is not known to both parties is

20 discovered in the future, the parties shall immediately disclose

21 such fact to the other party and either divide said property

22 equally or petition this court for a division of such property.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the

24 written Separation Agreement heretofore entered into between the

25 parties dated March 23, 1993, in reference to the property rights

26 and relationships of the parties hereto, and a copy of which
