Gary L. Hutchinson, first being duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am the agent of Summit Minerals, Inc., a Colorado corporation, with an address at P.O. Box 110, Golden, Colorado 80402-0110. I am personally acquainted with the matters described in this affidavit, which is made pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS § 517.230.

Eureka Ventures, a Texas joint venture, whose last known address is 10777 Westheimer, Suite 900, Houston, Texas 77042, owns the unpatented mining claims described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Claims").

By virtue of that certain Deed of Trust, Security Agreement and Assignment of Proceeds dated effective August 22, 1986 and recorded in the official records of the Eureka County, Nevada Recorder's Office in Book 53, Page 149 on September 22, 1986, and that Supplemental Deed of Trust, Security Agreement and Assignment of Proceeds dated November 23, 1988 and recorded in the official records of the Eureka County, Nevada Recorder's Office in Book 193, Page 467 on January 26, 1989, Inspectorate International Finance, N.V. ("Inspectorate") obtained a security interest in the Claims.

By virtue of that certain Assignment, dated August 9, 1990 and recorded in the official records of the Eureka County, Nevada Recorder's Office in Book 213, Page 414, on September 7, 1990, Inspectorate assigned its security interest in the Claims to Summit Minerals, Inc. ("Summit"), a Colorado corporation.

Under cover of the letter on the preceding page, Summit Minerals, Inc. submitted to the United States Bureau of Land Management a rental fee of \$100 for each of the Claims for the assessment year ending September 1, 1994, as required by Public Law 102-381, 106 Stat. 1374, 1378-79, in lieu of the assessment work and filing requirements of federal law suspended by Public Law 102-381. On behalf of the owner, Eureka Ventures, and to protect Summit's security interest in the claims, Summit Minerals, Inc. intends to

hold the claims from 12:00 p.m. on September 1, 1993 until 11:59 a.m. on September 1, 1994.

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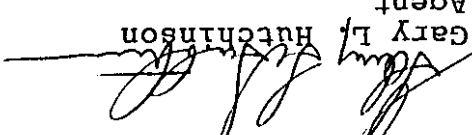
